The Ada City Council met in the Dr. Ray L. Stout City Council Chamber. Advanced public notice was given by posting the agenda on the City Hall bulletin board and posting on the City of Ada website on Friday, April 17, 2026, at 3:20 p.m.

1. The meeting of the Ada City Council was called to order by Mayor Hudson at 5:45 p.m.

Mayor Hudson issued a proclamation designating the month of May as National Tennis Month.

- a. A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Ada to approve participation in settlements with Associated Pharmacies, Inc., JM Smith Corporation, Louisiana Wholesale Drug Company, Morris and Dickson Co., North Carolina Mutual Wholesale Drug Company, Inc. and United Natural Foods, Inc. and authorizing City Manager to execute the Remnant Defendants’ Combined Subdivision Participation and Release Form contained in the Remnant Defendants’ Settlement Agreement as Exhibit G and to take all actions required to effect the settlements.

City Attorney Frank Stout indicated that pharmaceutical manufacturers have proposed a settlement amount of \$12,000. He emphasized that the city would not pursue litigation, as the manufacturers requested the city’s participation in this process.

- b. Discussion of and action on bids for the Glenwood Park Improvements Bid #26-11-05 and give authorization for Mayor or her designee to execute any and all documents related to said project, including but not limited to the contract and notice to proceed.

City Manager Tommy Eaton stated that the CDBG grant for Glenwood Park improvements is nearly complete, with funds still available. Washita Valley Landscape Service LLC submitted the lowest bid among the two quotes received.

Motion made by Council Member Mankin to award the bid for the Glenwood Park Improvements Bid # 26-11-05 and give authorization for Mayor or her designee to execute any and all documents related to said project, including but not limited to the contract and notice to proceed to Washita Valley Landscape Service LLC as the lowest responsible bid in the amount of \$15,732.36. Purchasing Director Pam McKinzie addressed the council regarding the annual micro surfacing bid. Two bids were submitted, with Vance Brothers, Inc. being identified as the lowest responsible bidder.
