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4. Reports by City Manager and/or City Staff.

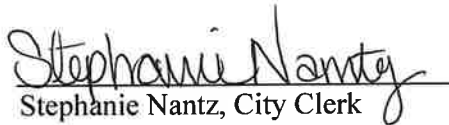
City Manager Tommy Eaton provided an update regarding the new interim finance director, who will be starting on Monday, July 13th.

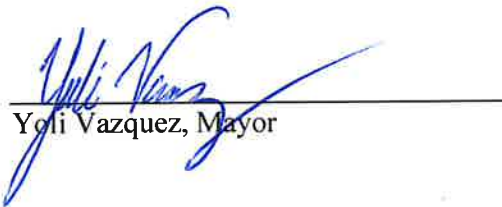
Assistant City Manager Angie Stout reported that a productive after-action review meeting was conducted with all relevant departments regarding the water line situation.
